Please pick a few activities to do with your child each week. Most of the activities should not take longer than a few minutes as they are meant to be quick and fun. Thank you for your support.

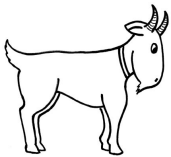
Week 1:

How far can you count in one minute? (Have a grown up help you.)

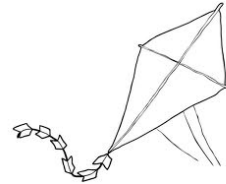
Write a story about an activity you did over Christmas break.

Look at the calendar and count how many days there are until your birthday. (Ask a grown up to help you.)

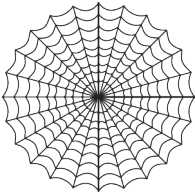
